

RESOLUTION No. 92-R-058

CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE RUN-OFF ELECTION
HELD ON MAY 30, 1992, FOR THE OFFICE OF
COUNCILMEMBER DISTRICT VII.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 92-R-045 dated May 4, 1992, the City ordered a run-off election to be held on May 30, 1992, to fill the vacancy in the Office of Councilmember for District VII; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 92-R-045 dated May 4, 1992, the City Council finding that no candidate received a majority of votes cast for that office of District VIII Councilmember, ordered that a run-off election be held on May 30, 1992.

WHEREAS, said City Council has investigated all matters pertaining to said run-off election on May 30, 1992, including the ordering, giving notice, and the election officers holding and making return of said election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to said City Council;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that said election was duly called and ordered, that proper notice was given, that election officers were properly appointed and held a properly conducted election, that due returns of the result of said election were made and delivered, all in accordance with the Election Code and the resolution calling said run-off election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said election for the following candidates for the office of District IV Councilmember by the resident, qualified electors of said District IV of the City of Laredo, who voted at said run-off election with the following result:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS:


