

RESOLUTION NO. 94-R-056

CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE RUN-OFF
ELECTION HELD ON JUNE 4, 1994, AND
APPROVING THE RESULTS.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 94-O-067 dated March 7, 1994, the Council ordered a general election to be held on May 7, 1994, to elect three at large and four district City officials:

WHEREAS, Resolution 94-R-045, dated May 9, 1994, canvassed the returns of said general election and ordered a run-off election between the two candidates who received the highest and second highest number of votes in said general election, namely, District II candidates Louis H. Bruni and Hector "Tito" Garcia, and District III candidates Alfonso I. "Poncho" Casso and Michael Landeck.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Laredo has investigated all matters pertaining to said run-off election, including the ordering, giving notice, and the election of officers holding and making returns of said general election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said run-off election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to said City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that said meeting was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes, Article 6552-17.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: The City Council finds and determines that said run-off election was duly called and ordered, that proper notice was duly given, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election, that said election was duly held, that due returns of the result of said run-off election were made and delivered, all in accordance with the Election Code and the resolution calling said run-off election; that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the resolution calling said run-off election.


Section 2: The City Council officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said run-off election for the following district candidates for the offices of District II and III Councilmembers by the resident, qualified electors of the City of Laredo, who voted at said run-off election with the following results:

DISTRICT II	VOTES	MAJORITY
Louis H. Bruni	627	56.94%
Hector "Tito" Garcia	474	43.05%

DISTRICT III	VOTES	MAJORITY
Alfonso I. "Poncho" Casso	582	58.55%
Michael Landeck	412	41.44%

Section 3: That the above returns of said run-off election be and are hereby approved and declared to be in due form as required by law, and that the candidates shown above receiving a majority of the votes for Districts II, III have been duly elected to the respective office, and that said successful candidates are entitled to fill the respective office by qualifying therefore as required by law.
