

ALARM PERMIT FEES

Each alarm permit is non-refundable and shall be valid for a twelve month period. Renewals will be billed automatically 30 days before expiration of the permit. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to pay the renewal fee prior to the expiration of their permit.

RESIDENTIAL EXEMPTION on Over 65, Disabled, Veterans, and Victims of Domestic Violence who meet #2 in the criteria below.	Exempt

REQUIRED SUPPORTING QUALIFICATIONS & DOCUMENTS

1. Residential Over 65 Permit: This fee applies to permit holders who are over 65 years of age. They will need to provide government filed or issued documents supporting qualification (Ex. a copy of a State issued I.D. or Driver's License) which validates their proof of age and that the alarm site is their residence.

2. Residential Exemption: This exemption applies to permit holders who are over 65 years of age, veterans, or disabled and whose household income falls within the U.S. Federal Poverty Guidelines. A copy of government filed or issued documents supporting qualification and address of alarm site must be provided. In addition, a victim who submits evidence of domestic violence within the previous 12 months, shall be exempt from the residential annual permit fee for that year.

FALSE CALL NOTIFICATION FEES

A false call notification is a call where the responding officer finds no evidence of the specified emergency (Burglary, Robbery, Medical, or Fire).

NON-PERMITTED SITES		
<i>An alarm subscriber, who is notified of a violation and does not obtain required permit within 30 days of notification, will be assessed the following fees for each alarm notification generated by a non-permitted alarm system, regardless of whether the alarm is false. Subscribers previously notified will be assessed fees without additional notification.</i>

	\$ 200.00	for each Fire, Medical, or Robbery Panic Alarm Notification
