**LAREDO, Texas** - The City of Laredo and Webb County have **18** new confirmed deaths in Webb County related to COVID-19. The City and County want to express their most sincere condolences to the families of those who have lost a loved one through this pandemic and want them to know that our counselors and our teams are available to support them.

The 633<sup>rd</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a female in her mid-70's. She died Saturday, January 30, 2021.

The 634<sup>th</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a male in his mid-40's. He died Friday, December 18, 2020.

The 635<sup>th</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a male in his late-70's. He died Sunday, December 20, 2020.

The 636<sup>th</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a female in her early-90's. She died Saturday, December 31, 2020.

The 637<sup>th</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a male in his early-70's. He died Tuesday, December 29, 2020.

The 638<sup>th</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a male in his mid-80's. He died Saturday, December 31, 2020.

The 639<sup>th</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a female in her early-70's. She died Wednesday, January 13, 2021.

The 640<sup>th</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a male in his early-80's. He died Thursday, January 14, 2021.

The 641<sup>st</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a male in his late-50's. He died Monday, January 18, 2021.

The 645<sup>th</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a female in her early-70's. She died Friday, January 08, 2021.

The 646<sup>th</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a male in his mid-70's. He died Monday, January 18, 2021.

The 647<sup>th</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a female in her late-60's. She died Friday, January 08, 2021.

The 648<sup>th</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a male in his mid-90's. He died Wednesday, January 13, 2021.

The 649<sup>th</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a female in her mid-70's. She died Tuesday, January 26, 2021.

The 650<sup>th</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a female in her late-70's. She died Monday, February 01, 2021.

Stay home if you are sick and call your doctor. Do not go to the doctor's office, call your doctor first. If it is an emergency, call 9-1-1.

As of **12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 02, 2021**, a total of: 276,348 people have been tested; 40,548 have resulted positive (1,413 are active); 38,485 persons have estimated recovered; 203 are currently hospitalized (68 of which are in the ICU), hospitalization rate is at 42.59% and 650 people have died.

In order to safeguard legally-protected information, the City of Laredo is not publicly releasing personal or identifiable information regarding any cases as it relates to COVID-19, results or monitoring.

Please continue to do your part in preventing the spread of all diseases. Follow the guidelines below:

- Follow CDC and WHO guidelines and practice physical distancing

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Hand sanitizer can be used when soap and water are not readily available
- Wear a mask or face covering
