## **City, County Confirm No New COVID-19 Related Deaths**

**LAREDO, Texas** - The City of Laredo and Webb County have **NO** new confirmed deaths in Webb County related to COVID-19. The City and County want to express their most sincere condolences to the families of those who have lost a loved one

Stay home if you are sick and call your doctor. Do not go to the doctor's office, call your doctor first. If it is an emergency, call 9-1-1.

As of **12:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 13, 2021**, a total of: 310,180 people have been tested; 42,932 have resulted positive (113 are estimated active); 42,017 persons have estimated recovered; 27 are currently hospitalized (11 of which are in the ICU), hospitalization rate is at 5.77% and 802 people have died.

In order to safeguard legally-protected information, the City of Laredo is not publicly releasing personal or identifiable information regarding any cases as it relates to COVID-19, results or monitoring.

Please continue to do your part in preventing the spread of all diseases. Follow the guidelines below:

- Follow CDC and WHO guidelines and practice physical distancing
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Hand sanitizer can be used when soap and water are not readily available
- Wear a mask or face covering
- Avoid touching your face
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Stay home when you are sick
- Cover all coughs and sneezes
- Clean frequently-touched surfaces
