## **City, County Confirm New COVID-19 Related Deaths**

**LAREDO, Texas** - The City of Laredo and Webb County have **TWO** new confirmed deaths related to COVID-19. The City and County want to express their most sincere condolences to the families of those who have lost a loved one through this pandemic and want them to know that our counselors and teams are available to support them.

- The 842<sup>nd</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a female in her early-80s. She died on Thursday, January 14, 2021.
- The 843<sup>rd</sup> death of a Webb County resident was a female in her late-50s. She died on Wednesday, May 26, 2021.

Stay home if you are sick and call your doctor. Do not go to the doctor's office, call your doctor first. If it is an emergency, call 9-1-1.

As of 10:30 a.m. on Thursday, June 3, 2021, a total of: 347,433 people have been tested; 44,229 have resulted positive; 41 are estimated active (**5/28/21: 61; 5/29/21: 48; 5/30/21: 47; 5/31/21: 41; 6/1/21: 36; 6/2/21: 36**); 43,345 are estimated recovered (**5/28/21: 43,289; 5/29/21: 43,304; 5/30/21: 43,308; 5/31/21:**

43,318; 6/1/21: 43,326; 6/2/21: 43,333); 12 are currently hospitalized (3 of which are in the ICU); hospitalization rate is at 3.70% as of 6/1/21 (5/26/21: 3.00%; 5/27/21: 3.29%; 5/28/21: 3.40%; 5/29/21: 3.36%; 5/30/21: 3.54%; 05/31/2021: 3.25%) and 843 people have died.

### **Vaccine Statistics:**

- First Doses Administered: 165,672 (76.73%)
- Fully Vaccinated: 130,400 (60.39%)
- 65+ Pop. who have received a vaccine: 24,176 (89.80%)

In order to safeguard legally-protected information, the City of Laredo is not publicly releasing personal or identifiable information regarding any cases as it relates to COVID-19, results or monitoring.
