## **City, County Confirm No New COVID-19 Related Deaths**

**LAREDO, Texas** - The City of Laredo and Webb County have **NO** new confirmed deaths related to COVID-19. The City and County want to express their most sincere condolences to the families of those who have lost a loved one through this pandemic and want them to know that our counselors and teams are available to support them.

Stay home if you are sick and call your doctor. Do not go to the doctor's office, call your doctor first. If it is an emergency, call 9-1-1.

As of 10:30 a.m. on Thursday, June 17, 2021, a total of: 350,481 people have been tested; 44,394 have resulted positive; 77 are estimated active (**6/11/21: 62; 6/12/21: 60; 6/13/21: 51; 6/14/21: 49; 6/15/21: 62; 6/16/21: 68**); 43,473 are estimated recovered (**6/11/21: 43,410; 6/12/21: 43,422; 6/13/21: 43,438; 6/14/21: 43,446; 6/15/21: 43,457; 6/16/21: 43,466**); 15 are currently hospitalized; 4 in ICU. The hospitalization rate is at 3.50% as of 6/15/21 (**6/09/21: 3.10%; 6/10/21: 3.53%; 6/11/21: 3.68%; 6/12/21: 3.61%; 6/13/21: 3.64%; 6/14/2021: 3.82%**) and 844 people have died.

## Vaccine Statistics:

- First Doses Administered: 173,524 (80.37%)
- Fully Vaccinated: 142,024 (65.78%)
- 65+ Pop. who have received a vaccine: 24,467 (90.88%)

In order to safeguard legally-protected information, the City of Laredo is not publicly releasing personal or identifiable information regarding any cases as it relates to COVID-19, results or monitoring.
