City, County Confirm New COVID-19 Related Deaths

LAREDO, Texas—The City of Laredo and Webb County have confirmed three new deaths in Webb County related to COVID-19. The City and County want to express their most sincere condolences to the families of those who have lost a loved one and want them to know that our counselors and our teams are available to support them.

293rd death is a male in his early-50s. He passed away on Saturday, September 26, 2020.

294th death is a male in his early-70s. He passed away on Sunday, September 27, 2020.

295th death is a male in his early-70s. He passed away on Saturday, September 26, 2020.

Stay home if you are sick and call your doctor. Do not go to the doctor's office, call your doctor first. If it is an emergency, call 9-1-1.

As of 12:00 p.m. on Monday, September 28, 2020, a total of 54,985 people have been tested, 13,775 have resulted positive (554 are active), 12,926 persons have estimated recovered, 90 are currently hospitalized (45 of which are in the ICU), hospitalization rate is 25.5% and 295 have died.

In order to safeguard legally-protected information, the City of Laredo is not publically releasing personal or identifiable information regarding any cases as it relates to COVID-19 testing, results or monitoring.

Please continue to do your part in preventing the spread of all diseases. Follow the guidelines below:

- Follow CDC and WHO guidelines and practice physical distancing
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Hand sanitizer can be used when soap and water are not readily available
- Wear a mask or face covering
- Avoid touching your face
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Stay home when you're sick
- Cover all coughs and sneezes
- Clean frequently-touched surfaces
