City, County Confirm New COVID-19 Related Deaths

LAREDO, Texas—The City of Laredo and Webb County have confirmed three new deaths in Webb County related to COVID-19. The City and County want to express their most sincere condolences to the families of those who have lost a loved one and want them to know that our counselors and our teams are available to support them.

The 306th death of a Webb County resident was a male in his late 80s. He died on Friday, October 02, 2020

The 307th death of a Webb County resident was a female in her early 60s. She died on Friday, October 02, 2020

The 308th death of a Webb County resident was a female in her early 90s. She died on Friday, October 02, 2020

Stay home if you are sick and call your doctor. Do not go to the doctor's office, call your doctor first. If it is an emergency, call 9-1-1.

As of 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 03, 2020, a total of 57,256 people have been tested, 14,141 have resulted positive (391 are active), 13,442 persons have estimated

recovered, 80 are currently hospitalized (44 of which are in the ICU), hospitalization rate 22.79%, and 308 have died.

In order to safeguard legally-protected information, the City of Laredo is not publically releasing personal or identifiable information regarding any cases as it relates to COVID-19 testing, results or monitoring.

Please continue to do your part in preventing the spread of all diseases. Follow the guidelines below:

- Follow CDC and WHO guidelines and practice physical distancing
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Hand sanitizer can be used when soap and water are not readily available
- Wear a mask or face covering
- Avoid touching your face
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Stay home when you're sick
- Cover all coughs and sneezes
- Clean frequently-touched surfaces
