Covered Services in accordance with Executive Order GA-23

The following list of Businesses are allowed to open but must follow the minimum standard health protocols as identified in the Governor's Strike Force to Open Texas which can be found at <https://gov.texas.gov/organization/opentexas>

Dine-in Restaurants	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can operate at up to 50% of the facility's total listed occupancy (not including employees)• Occupancy limit does not include outdoor seating areas• No tables of more than 6 people• Interactive functions or exhibits, including child play areas, interactive games, and video arcades must remain closed
In-Store Retail Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• May operate at up to 25% of the facility's total listed occupancy (not including employees)• Encouraged to continue providing retail-to-go and curbside delivery services
Salons (cosmetology salons, hair salons, barber shops, nail salons, tanning salons, etc.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must ensure at least six feet of social distancing between operating workstations• Face masks or facial coverings should always be worn by employees and clients• It is recommended that customers wait outside or in their vehicle and salons use a reservation/appointment system
Child Care Centers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• May operate only as permitted by Texas Law and in accordance with the minimum standard health Protocols identified in the Governor's Strike Force to Open Texas• Groups sizes should be stable, with the same children and caregivers in the same group every day

<p>Churches/Places of Worship</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure proper spacing between attendees • Keep at least 2 empty seats between parties in any row • Alternate rows between attendees (every other row left empty)
<p>Shopping Malls</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can operate at up to 25% of the facility's total listed occupancy (not including employees) • Food court dining areas, play areas, and interactive displays must remain closed
<p>Movie Theatres</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can operate at up to 25% of the facility's total listed occupancy (not including employees)
<p>Museums</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can operate at up to 25% of the facility's total listed occupancy (not including employees) • Interactive displays and child play areas must remain closed
<p>Libraries</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Local Public Libraries can operate only if permitted by Local Government • City of Laredo Public Libraries are currently closed as per the decision of the Local Government • Can operate at up to 25% of the total listed occupancy (not including employees)
<p>Golf Course Operations</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Except for members of the same household, no more than one individual per golf cart
<p>Wedding Venues/Wedding Receptions Services</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can operate at up to 25% of total listed occupancy for the facility (not including employees) • There is no occupancy limit for outdoor weddings • No tables of more than 6 people
<p>Swimming Pools</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Indoor and outdoor pools can operate at up to 25% of the facility's capacity • Public pools can operate only if permitted by the local government
<p>Massage Establishments</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can operate provided that they can ensure at least 6 feet social distancing between operating workstations • It is recommended that they schedule appointments to limit the amount of people in the establishment
<p>Tattoo/Piercing Studios</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can operate provided that they can ensure at least 6 feet social distancing between operating workstations

Personal Care/Beauty Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can operate provided that they can ensure at least 6 feet social distancing between operating workstations• It is recommended that they schedule appointments to limit the amount of people in the establishment
Bars	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can operate at up to 25% of the total listed occupancy of the establishment (not including employees)• Occupancy limits do not apply to outdoor areas• Any interactive functions or exhibits must remain closed• No tables of more than 6 people
Bowling Alleys	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can operate at up to 25% of total listed occupancy (not including employees)• Must ensure at least 6 feet of social distancing between operating lanes• Components of the establishment that have video arcades/interactive functions or exhibits must remain closed
Bingo Halls	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• May operate at up to 25% of total listed occupancy (not including employees)• Must ensure at least 6 feet of social distancing between customers playing bingo• Any components of the establishment that have interactive functions or exhibits must remain closed
Offices	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can operate up to the greater of five individuals or 25% of the employer's total workforce• Must ensure that individuals maintain appropriate social distancing measures
Manufacturing Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can operate at up to 25% of the facility's total listed occupancy
