City Issues Travel Advisory Ahead of 4th of July Weekend

LAREDO, Texas—The City of Laredo is issuing a travel advisory ahead of the Independence Day holiday and extended weekend. Residents are asked to stay home and celebrate only with those who live in the same household.

“Many counties in Texas and across the United States and Mexico are currently experiencing high levels of infection,” said City of Laredo Health Authority Victor Treviño, M.D. “It is not safe for people to travel during this time. We also remind the public that within Laredo, we are currently at Level 4 – Highest Risk and hospitals are reaching capacity. Please celebrate with your own household and do not invite others over. We will get through this, but we need everyone to cooperate to help flatten the curve.”

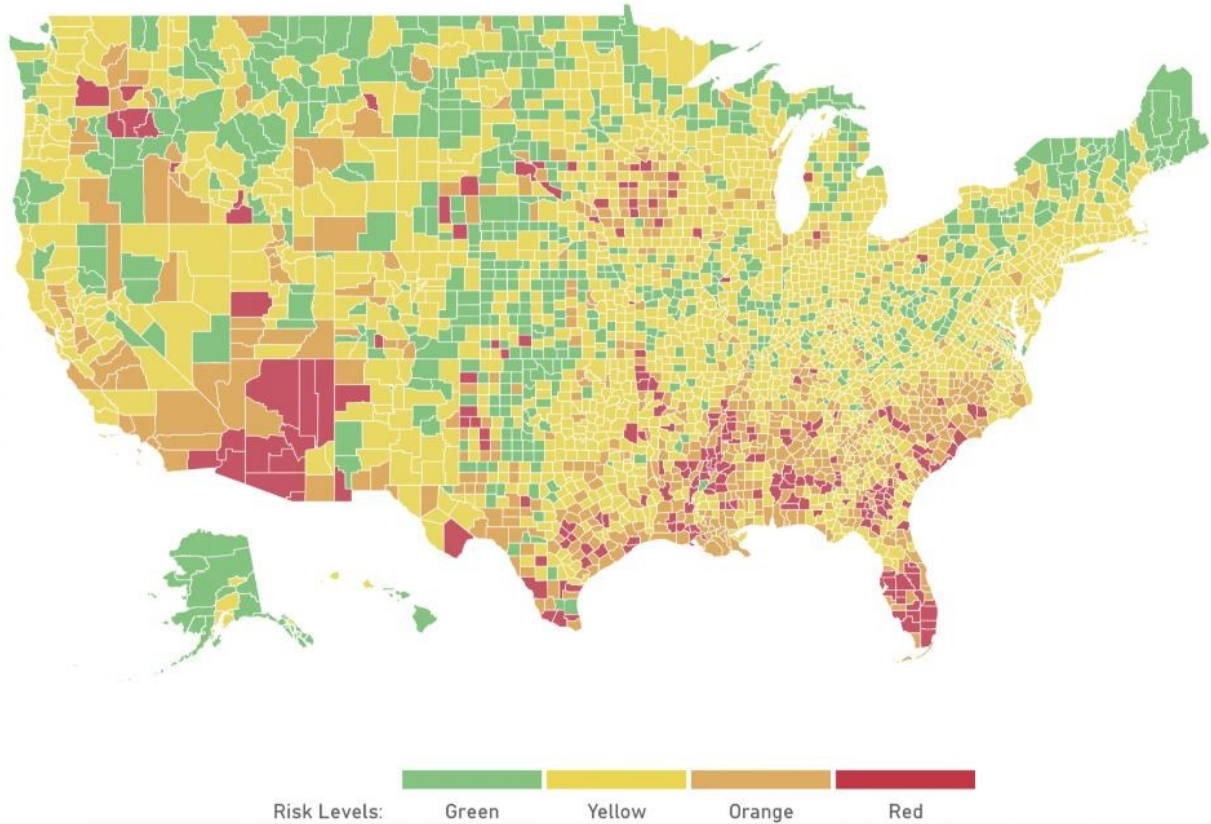
