### **Numerous Establishments Ordered Closed for Violating City's Public Health Control Measures**

**LAREDO, Texas**—The City of Laredo, under the direction of the City Manager, the City Attorney's Office and the Laredo Police Department carried out coordinated efforts to ensure that all establishments were abiding by the city's public health control measures as ordered by the Local Health Authority and the City Council.

Specifically, these establishments were not abiding by the Public Health Emergency Order as it relates to keeping logs, requiring the use of face coverings for both employees and clients, and enforcing social distancing measures.

The City continues to enforce all local health control measures during the current public health emergency caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. These measures are necessary for the protection of public health and to mitigate the local spread of the disease.

As a result, the following amusement redemption centers (*maquinitas*) have been ordered closed by various district court judges. More information will be forthcoming.
